First and foremost, the PTO mirrors the school-wide expectations of being **Responsible, Respectful, Safe, and Kind** while on school property after hours, and at all other venues where PTO events are held.

We thoroughly enjoy planning and executing events for the entire school community. However, at some of our events we are limited by space constraints and/or by the number of volunteers on hand. In these instances, the safety of our children can become a real concern. Therefore, we are asking each family to take the “**unsigned pledge**” by simply taking a few minutes to review the following with your children:

- ✓ School-wide expectations of being **Responsible, Respectful, Safe, and Kind**
- ✓ School rules, policies and guidelines apply for events held on school property (see the Page School Handbook)
- ✓ **ALL** children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian until the event concludes.
- ✓ Have fun with friends both new & old and laugh a lot!
